Position Summary: The Compressor Mechanic is responsible for performing skilled tasks including all levels of field maintenance, troubleshooting, direct repairs, overhauls and scheduled preventative maintenance on company owned compressors/generators This role reports to the Compression Lead.

- Optimize compression performance based on varying field conditions
- Inspect lease sites, ensure they are clean and maintained; check for spills and fluid leaks

- Ensure active and open communication with field operations
- Perform other duties and activities as assigned
